FAKTOR-FAKTOR YANG BERHUBUNGAN DENGAN MOTIVASI MASYARAKAT MENGIKUTI PROGRAM VAKSINASI COVID 19 DI RSAU dr. SISWANTO

Latar Belakang: Perawat dalam melaksanakan tugas sebagai garda terdepan penanganan, pencegahan, dan perawatan pasien Covid-19 mengalami kecemasan karena disebabkan oleh beberapa faktor, usia, jenis kelamin, pendidikan, status kesehatan, mekanisme coping, beban kerja, ketersediaan Alat Pelindung Diri (APD), dan pengetahuan.

Tujuan : Untuk mengetahui faktor-faktor yang berhubungan dengan motivasi masyarakat mengikuti program vaksinasi Covid-19 di RSAU dr. Siswanto.

Metode: Penelitian ini merupakan penelitian kuantitatif dengan pendekatan desain *cross sectional*. Populasi penelitian adalah masyarakat yang mengikuti program vaksin Covid19 di RSAU dr. Siswanto yang memenuhi kriteria sebanyak 56 responden dengan teknik sampling total sampling. Analisa data menggunakan analisis univariat, bivariat dengan uji *Kendall's tau-b* dan analisis multivariat menggunakan analisis uji regresi linier berganda.

Hasil : Hasil dari penelitian yang sudah diuji secara statistik dengan analisis uji *Kendall tau-b* diketahui variabel usia, jenis kelamin, pendidikan dan pekerjaan tidak berhubungan terhadap motivasi, sedangkan dengan uji multivariat diketahui variabel pengetahuan dan keyakinan secara simultan berpengaruh terhadap motivasi melaksanakan program vaksin Covid19 di RSAU dr. Siswanto dengan nilai *p value* 0,001.

Kesimpulan : Berdasarkan hasil penelitian maka dapat disimpulkan bahwa faktor-faktor yang berhubungan dengan motivasi masyarakat mengikuti program vaksin Covid-19 di RSAU dr. Siswanto Surakarta adalah pengetahuan dan keyakinan.

ABSTRACT

THE FACTORS OF COMMUNITY MOTIVATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE COVID-19 VACCINATION PROGRAM AT RSAU DR. SISWANTO

Background: Nurses experience anxiety due to several factors, such as age, gender, education, health status, coping mechanisms, workload, availability of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), and knowledge in carrying out the task of handling, preventing and caring for Covid-19 patients.

Objectives: To determine the factors of people's motivation to participate in the Covid-19 vaccination program at RSAU dr. Siswanto.

Method: This research was a quantitative study with a cross sectional design approach. The research population was people who take part in the Covid19 vaccine program at RSAU dr. Siswanto with 56 respondents. The sampling technique used total sampling. Data analysis used univariate analysis, the bivariate analysis used Kendall's tau-b test, and multivariate analysis used multiple linear regression analysis.

Results: The Kendall tau-b test analysis shows that the variables age, gender, education and work were unrelated to motivation. Meanwhile, the multivariate test shows that knowledge and belief variables simultaneously affect motivation to carry out the Covid19 vaccine program at RSAU dr. Siswanto with a p value of 0.001.

Conclusion: Based on the study, it can be concluded that the factors of people's motivation to take part in the Covid-19 vaccine program in RSAU dr. Siswanto Surakarta is knowledge and belief.
